



BEDSIDE SLEEPER BASSINET

IMPORTANT INFORMATION • READ CAREFULLY

PARTS LIST





ASSEMBLY



Remove the bassinet parts and other contents from the carton and verify that all the parts listed above are present.



Start assembling the bassinet legs by attaching the crossbar to the legs as shown below. Plug the bottom crossbar into the socket in each leg. The crossbar should simply snap into place by depressing the lock button as you insert it into each leg.

Unfold the bassinet and look for the adjustable sliding brackets on each side labeled "A" and "B". Connect the bassinet to the legs by depressing the adjustment buttons on each side of the bassinet and sliding the brackets onto their corresponding legs until the cradle is in place and "8" is visible through the bracket window on each side as shown below.

Attach the handles to the tops of the legs by depressing the lock button, and clicking them into place.



ASSEMBLY



Place the mattress pad in the bassinet with the vinyl waterproof side facing up. Only use the fitted sheet that came with the bassinet. Do not place any other sheets, blankets, pillows, or anything else in the bassinet with the baby.



Assemble the bassinet support by clicking the parts together and then plug the bassinet support into the lower attachment points underneath the cradle as shown below. The barrier bar on the support should be facing up, not down. Push support pieces into the sockets until you hear them click into place.







Pull the cover flap over the barrier bar and secure it tightly with the attached Velcro straps located underneath the bassinet.


Secure all remaining Velcro strap underneath the bassinet to finish the assembly.



HEIGHT ADJUSTMENT

To raise or lower the bassinet, press the height adjustment buttons on both sides and move the bassinet to the desired height.

The base of the bassinet can be inclined slightly by adjusting the two sides to different levels. **This cannot be done** when the bassinet is in bedside sleeper mode. To ensure the safety of the infant, the maximum difference between the two sides is two positions.





BEDSIDE SLEEPER MODE:

Assemble product according to manufacturer's instructions for ANY use mode—bedside sleeper as well as the bassinet. Always use ALL required parts for each use mode. Check instruction manual for a list of required parts. Periodically check product for loose, damaged, or missing parts. DO NOT USE BASSINET if any part is loose, damaged, or missing.

- This bassinet can only be used as a bedside sleeper with adult beds that are between 23 and 31 inches from the floor to the top of the adult mattress.
- •This bassinet can only be used as a bedside sleeper with adult beds that have all parts including frame, box spring, and mattress aligned. See **Figure 1** for acceptable and unacceptable bed frame configurations.
- A bedside sleeper is designed to provide a sleeping area for an infant until he or she begins to push up on hands and knees or approximately 5 months of age. Move your child to another sleeping product when your child reaches this stage.
- The bassinet must be firmly pressed against the adult mattress when in bedside sleeper mode. The legs can either go under the bed or for use with divan type beds, the legs can be pushed against the wall of the adult bed so that they contract and the bassinet is pressed against the adult mattress.



1 Zip down the mesh window wall on both sides and detach the top bar by sliding the bar adjustment button and lifting the bar out of the top wall on both sides as shown below in **Figure 2**.







- 2 Adjust the bassinet height so that the top of the barrier wall is even with the top of the adult mattress as shown in Figure 3. The bassinet must be set at an even height with no incline.
- 3 Attach each of the bed straps to the buckles underneath the bassinet on each leg as shown in Figure 4.
- 4 Wrap each strap around the structure of the bed. If your bed does not have a box spring wrap the straps around the frame. If your bed has a box spring, wrap the straps around the box spring.
- 5 Plug the end of each strap into the open buckles at the bassinet frame and pull the straps tight so that the bassinet is firmly pressed against the bed as shown. There should be little or no movement when finished.
- 6 Make sure the zip down wall is tucked between the mattress and bassinet and is not folded into the bassinet.

⚠ WARNING: BEFORE EACH USE MAKE SURE THAT THE STRAPS ARE TIGHT BY PULLING THE BASSINET AWAY FROM THE ADULT BED. IF THE GAP EXCEEDS ½ INCH DO NOT USE.

Do not fill the gap with pillows, blankets or other items that are suffocation hazards.

MARNING: WHILE IN USE, MAKE SURE THAT THE PARENT'S BED SHEETS, BLANKETS ETC. DON'T COVER ANY PART OF THE CRIB.

BASSINET MODE:

- 1 Unplug the connector straps from underneath the bassinet. You may first need to loosen them.
- 2 Store the connector straps in the mesh pocket that is located underneath the bassinet.
- 3 Attach the top bar to the bassinet by sliding the adjustment button on the side of the bar and locking the bar into place. Do this for both sides, then fully zip up the mesh walls.
- A Depress the height adjustment buttons to lift the bassinet to a height that is comfortable to reach inside.

The unit is designed to have some give when set up in bassinet mode, which allows for gentle rocking movement. If the unit shakes a lot, check that all screws and connections are tight and DO NOT USE if the unit is not secure.

TO FOLD THE BASSINET

FOR TRAVEL OR STORAGE:

- 1 Open all Velcro fasteners underneath the bassinet.
- 1 Uncover the barrier wall.
- 3 Remove the handles by pressing on the lock button and pulling up.
- A Remove the bassinet support by pushing the lock button and pulling out.
- Remove the mattress.
- 6 Lift the bassinet off of the legs by pressing the height adjustment button and pulling up.
- Detach the legs from the crossbar by pressing the lock button, and pulling out.
- 8 The bassinet can now be stowed in the carry case for travel or storage.

! FALL HAZARD


To help prevent falls, do not use this product when the infant begins to push up on hands and knees or has reached 20 lbs, whichever comes first. Always check that the bassinet is securely locked on the base/stand by pulling upwards on the bassinet bed.

Always secure the crib to the parents bed when used in bedside sleeper configuration, and before placing the baby, ensure that the connection belts are correctly hooked and tightened so that the product fits closely to the mattress of the parents and no spaces between the product and the adult mattress are present. The side can be zipped down only when the connector straps are tightly secured.

Never leave infant in bassinet with the side zipped down unless the unit is in the bedside sleeper configuration with the straps tightly secured to adult bed and the parents/caregiver is in the adult bed.

Contents of outer crib pockets must not exceed 35 lbs.

A bedside sleeper is designed to provide a sleeping area for an infant until he or she begins to push up on hands and knees or approximately 5 months of age. Move your child to another sleeping product when your child reaches this stage.



! SUFFOCATION HAZARD

INFANTS HAVE SUFFOCATED IN GAPS BETWEEN EXTRA PADDING AND SIDE OF THE BASSINET/CRADLE, AND ON SOFT BEDDING. USE ONLY THE PAD PROVIDED BY MANUFACTURER. NEVER ADD A PILLOW, COMFORTER, OR ANOTHER MATTRESS FOR PADDING.

TO REDUCE THE RISK OF SIDS, PEDIATRICIANS RECOMMEND HEALTHY INFANTS BE PLACED ON THEIR BACKS TO SLEEP, UNLESS OTHERWISE BY YOUR PHYSICIAN.

IF A SHEET IS USED WITH THE PAD, USE ONLY THE ONE PROVIDED BY THE BASSINET OR CRADLE MANUFACTURE OR ONE SPECIFICALLY DESIGNED TO FIT THE DIMENSION OF THE BASSINET OR CRADLE MATTRESS.

! ENTRAPMENT HAZARD

To prevent death from entrapment, bedside sleeper must be properly secured to adult bed using the attachment system.

- (1) There must be no more than 1/2 in. gap between bedside sleeper and adult bed.
- (2) Check tightness before each use by pulling bedside sleeper in a direction away from adult bed.
- (3) If gap exceeds 1/2 in. DO NOT use product.

Do not fill the gap with pillows, blankets or other items that are suffocation hazards.

Always read and follow assembly instructions for each product use mode.

Always use ALL required parts for each use mode.

Check instruction manual for a list of required parts. Periodically check product for loose, damaged, or missing parts.

To avoid death from the infant's neck being caught on the top rail on the side that is next to the adult bed, the top rail must be no higher than the adult bed mattress.

The connector straps must always be secured tightly to the adult bed when the bassinet is used in bedside sleeper mode.

The side can be zipped down only when the connector straps are tightly secured.

Never leave infant in bassinet with the side zipped down unless the unit is in the bedside sleeper configuration with the straps tightly secured to adult bed and the parents/caregiver is in the adult bed.

This bassinet can only be used as a bedside sleeper with adult beds that are between 23 and 31 inches from the floor to the top of the adult mattress.

WASHING INSTRUCTIONS:

Fitted Sheets

Machine wash cold and tumble dry low.

Mattress Encasement

Wipe down with a mildly soapy washcloth and hang to dry.

Bassinet Lining

Unzip lining and remove from the bassinet. Hand wash cold and hang to dry.

Check for damages on the product on a regular basis. Do not use if product is broken or damaged.

Do not use fabric softener, abrasive or aggressive products when cleaning the product.

Do not bleach. Do not iron. Do not dry clean.
