


Setup Instructions:

Extend Shelter Frame
CAUTION: Avoid pinch points when
opening or closing the shelter frame.


 Expand and spread out SHELTER FRAME. (Fig. 1)

NOTE: Only extend SHELTER FRAME half way for easier placement of the CANOPY.



Attach Canopy


- Unfold CANOPY then drape over STEEL SHELTER FRAME. (Fig. 2)
- Locate HOOK & LOOP FASTENER on underside of the CORNER POCKET of the CANOPY. (Fig. 2)
- Attach HOOK & LOOP FASTENER to material located at the top of the STEEL SHELTER LEG. (Fig. 3)
- Repeat for remaining 3 CORNER CANOPY POCKETS. (Fig. 2 & 3)




Raising Roof Support Brackets

 Grasp the LEG POLE and push up on the ROOF SUPPORT BRACKET until the ORANGE BUTTON "clicks" into locked position. (Fig. 4)

 Repeat for remaining 3 ROOF SUPPORT BRACKETS to fully raise the ROOF PEAK. (Fig. 5)





Telescoping Steel Frame Legs


Grasp and extend TELESCOPING LEG POLE until the silver LOCKING BUTTON "clicks" into locked position.



• Repeat for remaining 3

LEG POLES.

NOTE: When telescoping the


legs, the silver locking pin will lock in the lowest setting first. Push in the pin and extend the leg further to desired shelter height. (Fig. 8)





Secure Canopy to Frame

- Locate HOOK & LOOP FASTENERS along the seam of the underside of the CANOPY; then wrap around METAL BRACE to secure. (Fig. 9)
- Repeat for remaining 3 sides of the shelter CANOPY.
- Position the gazebo shelter in its final position before securing with stakes and guylines.

To Secure Shelter:

Stake Shelter

• Locate FOOT at the bottom of each SHELTER LEG POLE location (4 total). • Slide STAKE through HOLE at each location; then gently extend out before securing. (Fig. 10) **NOTE**: Shelter should be taut when staked properly.


Secure Guylines

 Locate GUYLINES attached to the shelter and unroll.

· Slide STAKE through loop at each location, extend out and drive in to secure. (Fig. 11)

NOTE: Four corner GUYLINES should extend out at a 45° angle from shelter.

 Tighten GUYLINES as needed by adjusting the SLIDER up the cord.






To Take Down Shelter

NOTE: For long-term storage: Remove the CANOPY & store separately.

For short-term storage (1-2 weeks): It is acceptable to leave the CANOPY attached to STEEL SHELTER FRAME. Follow the previous steps and illustrations on the front side of this tag in the reverse order:

- Remember to push the silver LOCKING BUTTON and telescope the 4 on the LEG POLES. (Fig. 12)
- Remember to push the 4 ORANGE BUTTONS to release the ROOF SUPPORT BRACKET. (Fig. 13)
- Fold CANOPY and put back into the bag.
- Fold up STEEL SHELTER FRAME and place into bag.





Storing the Shelter

- Remove guylines and stakes and place in their storage bag.
- All stakes must be placed in their own storage bag before placing in tent carrying case to prevent damage to the shelter fabric.
- Store in a clean, dry area

IMPORTANT FACTS:

- Never store shelter, even for a short period of time, without drying it thoroughly and brushing off caked dirt. Do not pack stakes inside your shelter. Use a separate storage bag.
- STAKES SHOULD BE REMOVED BY PULLING ON THE STAKE ITSELF. NEVER PULL ON THE SHELTER TO REMOVE STAKE.
- . Do not leave your shelter set-up for weeks at a time. Be aware that exposure to ultraviolet ravs from the sun can seriously damage material and/ or cause it to become discolored.
